



Subcontractor Prequalification

All Subcontractors working for SOLV Energy (SOLV) must be prequalified **and** have an executed Master Subcontractor Agreement (MSA) + Work Order on file prior to start of work on a SOLV jobsite.

Prequalification is the process of reviewing information to gain insight into the overall capabilities of a subcontractor. Areas of review may include safety, bond rating, project history, and financial information.

Documents

Email the completed prequalification application and all documents listed below to Prequalification@solvenergy.com

1. Completed Subcontractor Prequalification Application.
2. Last 3 years of OSHA Forms 300 & 300A;
If you are exempt from OSHA recordkeeping, please include a statement with the reason for your exemption with your documents. If no injuries indicated on 300A, please include 300 regardless. If EMR is 1.25 or greater, include Letter of Explanation and Safety Program/Procedures/Policy improvements.
3. Copy of Field Based Safety Program & Substance Abuse Policy.
4. Current Certificate of Insurance; and
5. ***Bond rate is required for prequalification above \$1M.**

Additional documents may be required based on subcontract scope and/or amount, including but not limited to current financial information.
